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Comparing Procrastination in Public and Private Sector Bank Employees of Chandigarh

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Abstract

There are many negative effects of procrastination. It keeps tension at the forefront. The banking industry is not immune to the negative effects of procrastination, which include wastage of time and reduced efficiency of employees as well as banks. Due to procrastination so many activities of commercial banks are affected which is not a good sign and it can be lead to lost of faith in their valuable customers. The current study looked at how much procrastination there was among bank personnel in the public and private sector banks. 180 workers comprised the study's sample. The information from respondents was gathered using a pure-procrastination scale. The scale's dependability or reliability was put to the test. The data demonstrates the differences in procrastination between staff of public and private banks. We also discussed the practical implications of this study and its limitations.
